Centre

The Alteya Established in April 2024, the Alteya Rehabilitation **Rehabilitation** Centre is a premier social and healthcare facility operated by the Alteya Cooperative in the Castelli Romani area. The Centre enhances the cooperative's existing network, which includes the Cittadina del Sociale in Galloro, Ariccia, the Casa Rifugio Dechomai – a refuge for women and minors who are victims of violence -, the Albano Polyclinic, and various other care services provided within the Roma 6 Local Healthcare Authority district. These services cater to minors, adults, disabled individuals, and those with psycho-social issues.







Who We Serve

Supported by a multidisciplinary team that includes Child Neuropsychiatrists, Physiatrists, Neurologists, and specialized Psychologists, alongside rehabilitation professionals such as physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech therapists, and developmental neuro-psychomotor therapists, the Centre offers comprehensive rehabilitation services which cannot be provided by outpatient specialist care facilities. These services are designed for individuals of all ages with complex physical, psychological, sensory, or combined disabilities, often presenting multiple challenges, including possible permanent outcomes.

Rehabilitation

Child We place special emphasis on the **prevention**, diagnosis, and treatment of physical, psychological, and sensory disabilities in children and youngsters aged o-18. Our rehabilitative treatments cover a wide range of childhood neuropsychiatric conditions, including cerebral palsy, autism spectrum disorders, intellectual disabilities, neurodevelopmental disorders, and sensory impairments such as hearing or vision loss.







Rehabilitative Our Centre is also dedicated to the treatment of Treatments adult patients with neurological, circulatory and for Adults musculoskeletal conditions. This includes care for cerebrovascular diseases and recovery from traumatic or post-surgical musculoskeletal conditions.

Our Objectives Our mission is to facilitate patient recovery by preserving residual abilities, nurturing potential, and enhancing the quality of life. We strive to empower our patients towards greater autonomy, involving family members in this journey whenever possible.





Outpatient We offer non-residential services, organised into and Home Care Outpatient and Home Care sectors. The Home **Services** Care services are available for those unable to access our outpatient facilities due to specific clinical conditions or mobility issues.

> Access to the Alteya Rehabilitation Centre is based on referrals from a Specialist Doctor within the Local Healthcare Authority or the user's local Health District (TSMREE/CAD).







Our Facility

The Rehabilitation Centre boasts a gym dedicated to physical rehabilitation alongside multiple clinics where we implement recovery programmes focusing on psychomotricity, speech therapy, and a range of recreational/motor and expressive activities, as defined by the medical care team. Located on the spacious and light-filled second floor of a building in a commercial area, our facility is easily accessible by public transport and offers ample public parking in the immediate vicinity.

Rehabilitative Treatments for Adults

Indirect Interventions

- ▶ A multidisciplinary team collaborates to set and review intervention goals within each Individual Rehabilitation Project (IRP)
- Counselling, parent training, parent coaching, classroom observation, and mediation as support activities for primary and secondary caregivers
- Participation in GLO (Operational Working Group) as provided by Law 104/1992

The Alteya Rehabilitation Centre is authorised to provide outpatient and home care services under Regional Determination No. Go3993 dated 9 April, 2024. Institutional accreditation is pending.
